

## 2010 WARREN COUNTY FAIR CHICKEN & RABBIT RULES

### Chickens

- C1. Extension reserves the right to reject any entry which is diseased or otherwise undesirable. Examples include:
- All chickens must have full beaks.
  - Chickens should have no sores on their feet.
  - Chickens should have no feathers missing.
  - Chickens should have all toenails.
  - Chickens should have both eyes.
  - There should be no scaling on the feet.
- C2. All exhibits must meet health requirements for poultry as listed in the Animal Health Regulations.
- C3. Exhibitors will clean their cages daily and will be responsible for care of their own animals. Exhibitors must provide their own water and feed pans.
- C4. All eggs must be removed from cages.
- C5. All entries will be accepted on Sunday, August 1<sup>st</sup>, between the hours of 1pm and 4pm.
- C6. **PLEASE READ ALL RULES! ALL RULES WILL BE INFORCED!**

### Rabbits

- R1. Extension reserves the right to reject any entry which is diseased or otherwise undesirable. Examples include:
- All toenails should be clipped.
  - No sore ears.
  - No runny eyes or noses.
  - No skin irritation or disease.
  - No feet problems.
- R2. Exhibitors will clean their cages daily and will be responsible for their own feeding and watering. Exhibitors must bring their own water bottles & feed pans.
- R3. Newborn rabbits will not be allowed in cages.
- R4. All 4-H entries must be personally managed and cared for by the exhibitor making the entry.
- R5. All entries will be accepted on Sunday, August 2<sup>nd</sup>, between the hours of 1pm and 4pm.
