

Rules

1. Current Negative Coggins (within 12 months) must be presented upon entering the show grounds.
2. Protective headgear must be worn when mounted.
3. Appropriate tack and attire are requested in all classes.
4. The judge's decision is final.
5. NO DOGS ALLOWED!
6. 4H Regulations prohibit entrants under the age of 9.
7. Each participant must sign an equine waiver form.
8. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry or to combine, change, divide and/or cancel any classes.
9. Classes will be judged according to the State 4-H Horse Show Rulebook.
10. The Virginia Cooperative Extension Office, Warren County 4-H and the Warren County Fairgrounds will not be held responsible for injuries to horses, riders or spectators or for damage or theft of property.
11. Virginia Cooperative Extension programs and employment are open to all, regardless of race, color, religion, sex, age, veteran status, national origin, disability, or political affiliation. If you are a person with a disability and require auxiliary aids, services, or other accommodations for this event, please discuss your needs with VCE at (540) 635-4549 two weeks prior to the event.
12. A two-minute gate call will be enforced.
13. Good sportsmanship and horsemanship will be enforced.
14. No alcoholic beverages permitted.
15. Ribbons to 6th place. Points awarded per show series guidelines, which are available from the show secretary.
16. The following definitions will apply:
Leadline: 5-8 years as of 9/30/2010
Junior: 9 - 13 years as of 9/30/2010
Senior: 14 - 19 years as of 9/30/2010
Open: All Ages

DIRECTIONS

From Front Royal or I-66 (Exit 6) go north on Rt. 340/522. Pass through the red light at Toray Drive. Turn right onto Fairground Road at the red light. The Fairgrounds are located on your right. Enter the grounds near the horse arena at the rear of the property.

From Double Tollgate (Dinosaur Land) go south on Rt. 340/522 for 4 miles until you reach the first red light at Fairgrounds Road. Take a left and the Fairgrounds will be on the right. Enter the grounds near the horse arena at the rear of the property.

The youth that accumulates the most points in Jr. Hunter, Western, Gaited, or Gymkanna and Sr. Hunter, Western, Gaited, or Gymkanna will win a fantastic *embroidered cooler* sponsored by the Frederick, Warren and Shenandoah County 4-H Horse Programs!

*Classes that count towards the FCS Awards include showmanship, pleasure/hunter under saddle, and horsemanship/equitation for western, hunter and gaited. All gymkanna classes count for that division. *Coolers will be awarded at the end of the Shenandoah County Show on August 29th, 2010.*
