RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Contestant must be a resident of Warren County. Proof of residence may be requested at any time.
2. Contestant must be between the ages of 8 years and no older than 10 years by July 24, 2010. Please provide proof of age at registration.
3. Contestant will be judged in a **pageant gown**. Contestant will be scored on beauty, personality, selection of dress and overall appearance. Top five will answer a spontaneous question.
4. The winner of the Little Miss Pageant must attend the Fair on dates scheduled by the Pageant Committee and Parents once winner is announced
5. Registration will be available starting June 8, 2010. An application and rules and regulations will be available via the Internet and available at the Warren County Fair Office. Applications can be mailed to Warren County Fair, P.O. Box 1555, Front Royal, VA 22630 or turned into the Fair Office in person.
6. A **non-refundable** registration/sponsor fee of \$35.00 is required of each contestant. Sponsors may be parents, relatives, businesses, etc. The Deadline for registration is July 24, 2010 by 5:00 p.m. **Entry fee shall be paid by cash, money order or check and made payable to Warren County Fair.**

7. Practice will be held at the Warren County Fairgrounds (stage area) and is **mandatory**. A representative (parent, guardian, family friend etc.) must attend during time assigned for each age group.
